Extra-Curricular Achievements

Among the many awards attained, BPS girls won four First Prizes at the latest HK SPEECH FESTIVAL English Solo Verse Speaking, and seven students took the first three places in Cantonese and Putonghua Solo Verse Speaking/ Prose Reading. In the HK Secondary Schools DEBATING Competition, our team won the Best Debater award; and the Gold Award & Poet of the School Award in the HK Budding Poets Competition. No less impressive are their achievements in Chinese debating, writing and speech

Academic Excellence

In the latest HK Diploma of Secondary Education Exams, our S6 students attained 40% of total subject entries at level 5 or better. 96% received JUPAS offers to continue their higher education. Our girls were also the proud recipients of the HK Island Top Ten Outstanding Student Award and HK Island Eastern District Outstanding Student Award.

Belilians won the HK Youth MUSIC Interflows Gold Award-String Ensemble Contest and Silver Award-Chinese Ensemble Contest, as well as the Outstanding Music Prize-Gala Musica School Creative Works 2022. In the 58th Inter School DANCE Festival, our teams were awarded with Gold, Silver and Merit Awards in multiple entries.

While many SPORTS competitions were cancelled in the last two years due to the Covid-19 pandemic, our girls did well in 2019-2020, winning Championships at the Inter-School Swimming Competition, Wan Chai Ping Pong Competition, and Haitong International HK Windsurfing Circuit Year Ranking,

among other accolades. In 2021/22 our girls took the Senior Champion Honor in the Inter-school Badminton Competition, as well as 2022 HK Figure Skating & Short track Speed Skating Championships Junior Women-First Place.

In the realm of CREATIVITY, BPS girls were honored with eLearning Development Laboratory Young Maker Cup's Robot League Best Presentation, Best Rescue and Best Innovation Awards; Gold, Silver & Merit Awards at the 4th Inter-School English Calligraphy and Art Competition, and the HK International Youth Artist Society-Excellence & Most Creative Award. They also swept the HK School Drama Festival-Awards for Outstanding Cantonese Drama Script, Director, Actor, Stage Effect and Cooperation!



Support for Student Development

A Whole School Approach is being adopted to facilitate students' all-round development. Pastoral services encompassing career and life planning guidance, cross-curricular programs, discipline, co-curricular activities, service education, environmental education, counselling, moral, civic and national education work hand in hand with the school's commitment to whole person development.

Three Life Wide Learning periods in alternate cycle were structured in the time table to facilitate the implementation of a wide variety of student-centred activities such as Stress Handling, Project Slash, Mental Health and Self-Directed Learning Workshops, My Life Planning Portfolio, Internet Proper Use, Art + Technology, Music Appreciation and Intangible Cultural Heritage Sessions.

To assist students with financial difficulties, the funding from the School-Based Grant was fully utilized to ensure every student would have the opportunity to broaden horizons and explore new frontiers in our global village.

Catering for Learning Diversity

Catering to diversity of students' learning abilities, BPS has instituted the following measures:

- Provision of a broad curriculum with a wide range of subject choices including NSS Music Studies
- Curriculum Planning, tailoring and adapting to varied abilities
- Collaborative Learning Strategies to promote peer learning and mutual support
- Adaptation of Assessment to recognize different abilities
- Enhancement and Enrichment programs for both the gifted and the disadvantaged students
- Deployment of various grants to employ extra teachers and support staff
- Ethos-building to recognize diversity and individual differences

Volunteer Groups Community Service

There are 5 school service clubs: BPS Zonta Club, Community Youth Club, Girl Guides (120th Island Co.), Interact Club and UNICEF Club. In the last academic year, more than a dozen activities had been organized including 120th GG Towel Animals and Audible Books Making + Distribution to the solitary elderly in Shau Kel Wan (134 pax), Medecins Sans Frontieres Mapathon (110 pax), 4C Youth Volunteer Leadership Project (18 pax), and a Children Summer English Learning Program with Caine Rd Caritas Community Centre. Last but not least in terms of focus participation is the S1 Volunteer Work Basic Training and Student Sharing Presentation (140 pax).

The Foundation is run by alumnae on a voluntary basis and as such the Foundation has ZERO administration and salary expenses. All donations go straight to fund the various financial needs of BPS. Currently BOGF makes contribution of HKD 500,000.- or more every year in funding various school functions including

- 97 Permanent Scholarships awarded to worthy students every year
- Employment of a Full Time School IT Technician to enhance education internet connectivity
- Outsourced management of School Orchestra Music Instrumental classes
- Purchase of Teaching Aids and Equipment such as Computers, Interactive Panels, Science & Mathematics Teaching Equipment
- Publication of Award- Winning Student Essays in the annual BOGF Bilingual Creative Writing Competition
- Subsidy for Various Events including Overseas Interflows Activities for Students from Disadvantaged Backgrounds

New Permanent Scholarships Set Up Recently

Investment of Donated funds

Any multiples of HKD 50,000 establish one or more permanent BOGF scholarship(s). The permanent scholarship funds are invested by the Five Member BOGF Investment Committee in a portfolio of blue chip dividend stocks and income paying mutual funds. The annual income ONLY, not the principal, is being used to fund the permanent scholarships. Endowing a permanent scholarship therefore gives the following valuable benefits:

As part of the 130th Anniversary Fund Raiser, we received HKD 350,000 to set up / top up 6 permanent scholarships:

- 1965 HKD 100,000 from Ms K M Wong in honor of our retired Principal Mrs Mak Ho Yuk Yee
- HKD 50,000 from Ms L P Chow to top up her permanent scholarship in Chinese Calligraphy in honor of her father.
- HKD 100,000 from Ms T F Ko to top up her earlier donation for two permanent scholarships in honor of her parents.
- 1988 HKD 50,000 from Ms W L Wong for student with the best improvement in English
- 2002 HKD 50,000 from Ms L F Hsu in memory of her mother
